

# Lisle Hodell

1897 - 1989



Lisle Hodell served as General Manager of General Purpose Motors, General Electric. He developed the now widely-adapted matching conveyor system for which he received the Coffin Award in 1942. He and his gang built the Taylor Street Plant "part by part" in the hectic days following Pearl Harbor.

He was instrumental in laying out the Decatur, Linton, Tiffin, DeKalb and Kokomo plants in addition to facilities on Broadway. Hodell was also very active in the YMCA, United Way, and Bethany Presbyterian Church.
