

Max Irmischer, Sr.

1866 - 1935



It was as founder and president of Max Irmischer & Sons that Max Irmischer became best known in his adopted community. Of the many notable buildings his company built well into the early 20th century were the First National Bank building, the Mizpah Shrine Temple, the Water Filtration Plant, Wolf & Dessauer, the Emboyd (today's Embassy) and Paramount Theatres, North Side High School, and portions of the old St. Joseph Hospital. Not only did he build some of the leading turn-of-the-century structures in Fort Wayne, he also gave back to the community.
